Credit Recovery Rules and Regulations:

1. Attendance in each class is critical. A maximum of 3 absences will be allowed. This includes illness or doctor excuses. No exceptions. You must put in the required seat time.
2. A student must pass a proficiency exam at the end of the course to receive credit. Your grade for the class will be determined from the work and test during the course of the class with no more than 15% being your proficiency exam. BUT if you **do not pass the proficiency exam** even if your grade is an A, you **will not pass the course**.
3. Students are expected to conform to the same rules of conduct and dress code that are in effect during the regular school session. This includes **no cell phones**.
4. Credit recovery is an additional effort on the part of the school district to provide students the opportunity to make up deficiencies in required courses. The rights of all students to avail themselves of this opportunity, free of disruption and/or distraction, will be insured through a school setting conducive to learning. Students who fail to conform in an appropriate manner will be immediately expelled from credit recovery and will be subject to loss of credit and fees. Credit recovery grades, passing or otherwise, will become a permanent part of the student's school records/transcript.
