ELA, Science, and Social Studies

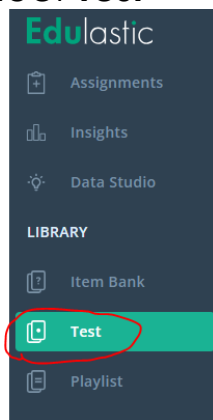
- Teachers will be informed once tests are published via email.
- You may assign the assessment when you are ready.
- If you notice a typo or other mistake on the assessment, ask your instructional coach to send Scarlet an email about the mistake and I'll correct it.
- **Important:** When a mistake is corrected such as a wrong answer marked and students have taken the test, the district admin may correct it and Edulastic will automatically rescore the test for the student to correct their personal scores. Nothing will need to be done by the teacher.

Reopen Assessments

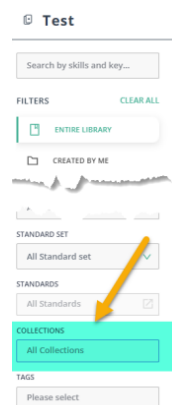
The redirect tool is a major feature you and your teachers need to be aware of regardless if it is a summative or formative assessment. Redirect will reopen the test for retakes, absent students, accidental submissions, and skipped questions. Redirect can be done by teachers or admin. 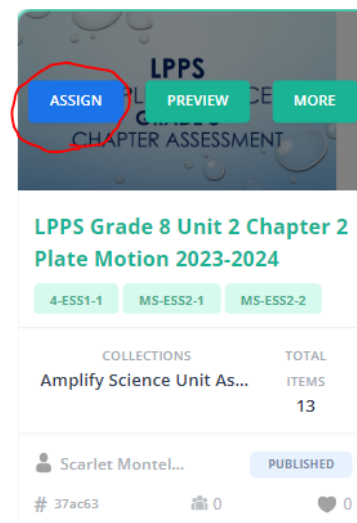
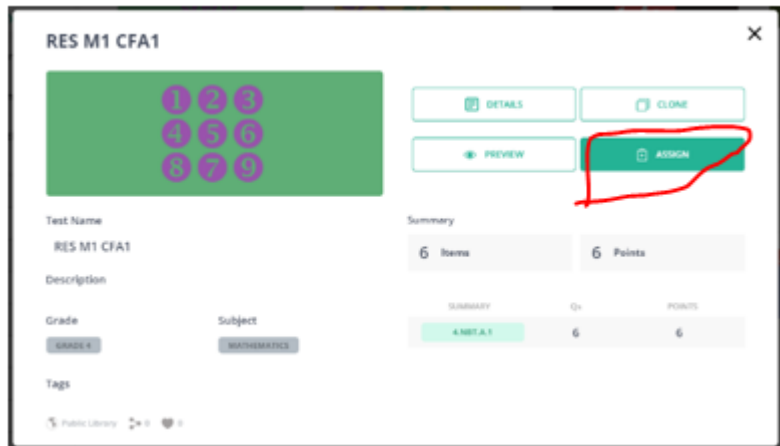

To assign to an entire class or multiple classes, click in the CLASS/GROUP SECTION field to Select one or more classes to take the assessment.

Or, you can choose to assign the assessment to specific students. Click the SPECIFIC STUDENT button, select a class as above, and then click in the STUDENT field to select them.

Select when you want the assignment to be available for students to take by inputting the start date, due date, and close date. Choosing USE OPEN AND CLOSE DATE makes the due date and close date the same.

USE OPEN AND CLOSE DATE USE OPEN, DUE AND CLOSE DATE (ALLOWS LATE SUBMISSIONS)

Choosing USE OPEN, DUE AND CLOSE DATE publishes a due date for students, but allows for late submissions before the assessment fully closes.

OPEN and CLOSE policies


Open Manually: Allows the teacher to assign the assessment now but give access to classes when they are ready.


Close Manually: Allows the teacher to keep the assessment open until all students finish the assessment. This does not affect reports or data.

CLOSE DATE: 2020-06-15 23:00:00 


USE OPEN AND CLOSE DATE USE OPEN, DUE AND CLOSE DATE (ALLOWS LATE SUBMISSIONS)


OPEN POLICY: Automatically on Start Date 


CLOSE POLICY: Automatically on Close Date 

You may choose to open and close either automatically or manually. Both choices are available for both functions.


OPEN POLICY: Automatically on Start Date 

CLOSE POLICY: Automatically on Close Date 

Automatically on Start Date 

Open Manually in Class 

Test Type: Here, it should say common assessment. The teacher should leave it as is or won't even have the option if the admin has selected Freeze Settings.

TEST TYPE: Common Assessment 

Click the assign button at the top right of their screen and both admin and teachers should see the assessment is assigned.
