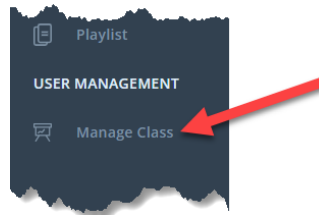


Enabling Text to Speech Accommodations

- From the teacher account, navigate to the Manage Class tab and locate the class with the student that requires the accommodation.

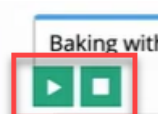


- Select the students for whom you need to enable text to speech by clicking on the box (orange arrow) next to their name.
- Click on ACTIONS (blue arrow) and select ENABLE TEXT TO SPEECH.
